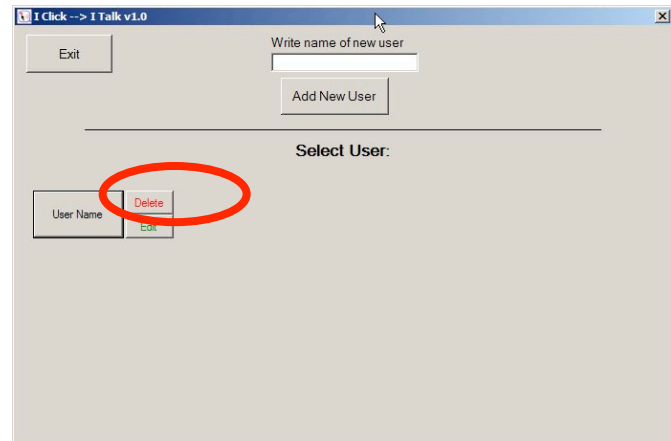


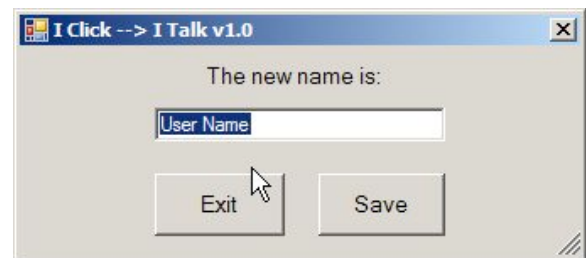
How to change the name of/delete a user in I Click → I Talk

Only for multiuser license

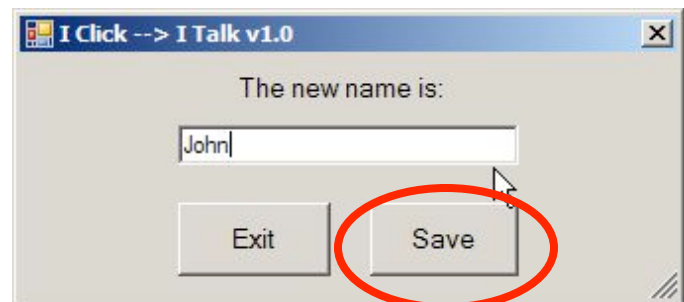
1. Click on the “Edit” button (in green) as shown in the image to the right.



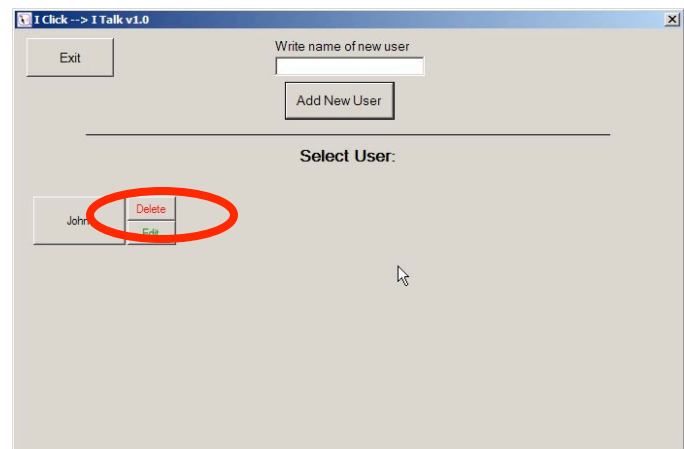
2. A new window will appear as shown in the image to the right.



3. Type the name of the new user, then click on the the Save button as shown in the image to the right.

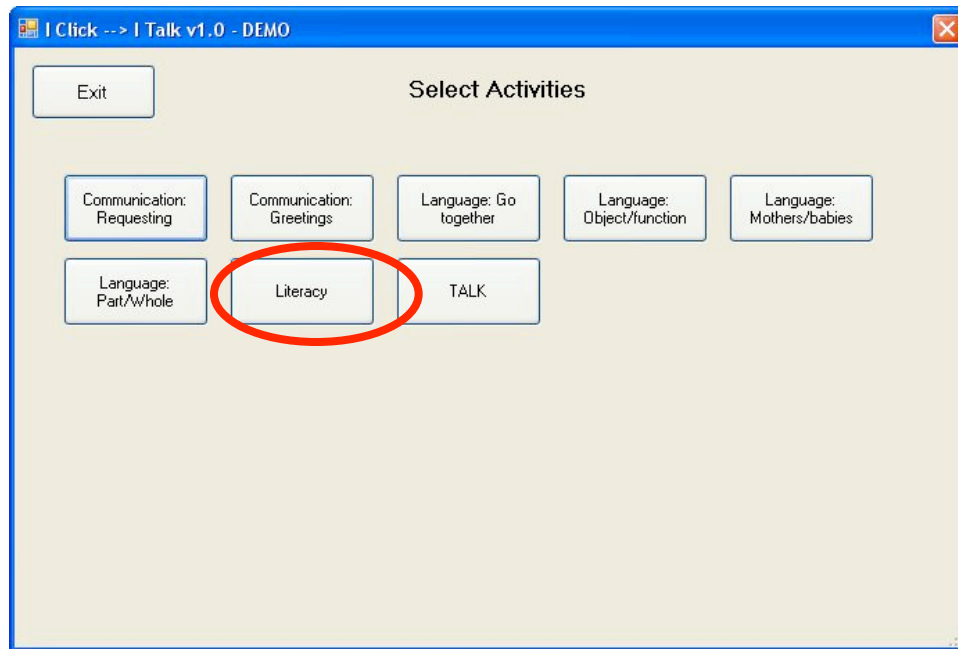


4. After you click, the the new name will appear. From this window you can also delete a user (**and lose all the the user's data**) by clicking on the Delete button (in red) as shown in the image to the right. Click on Exit button to return to the previous window.

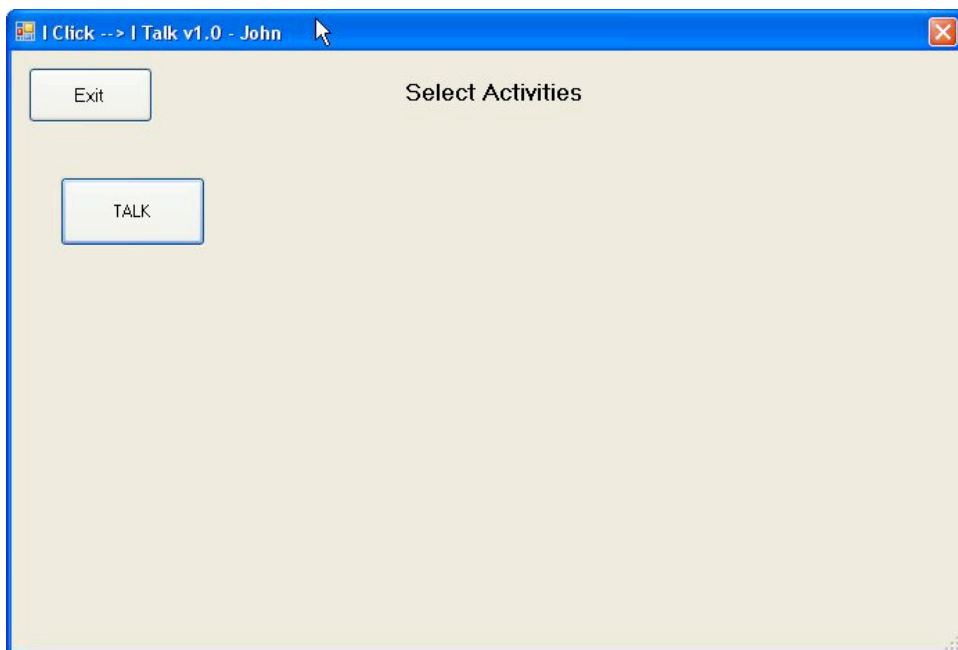


How to select an activity in I Click → I Talk

1. **ONLY FOR RED PACKAGE.** Click on the activity button you want to work with as shown in the image below (we have selected Literacy).



2. **ONLY FOR GREEN and YELLOW PACKAGES** Click on the TALK activity button as shown in the image below (we have selected Literacy).

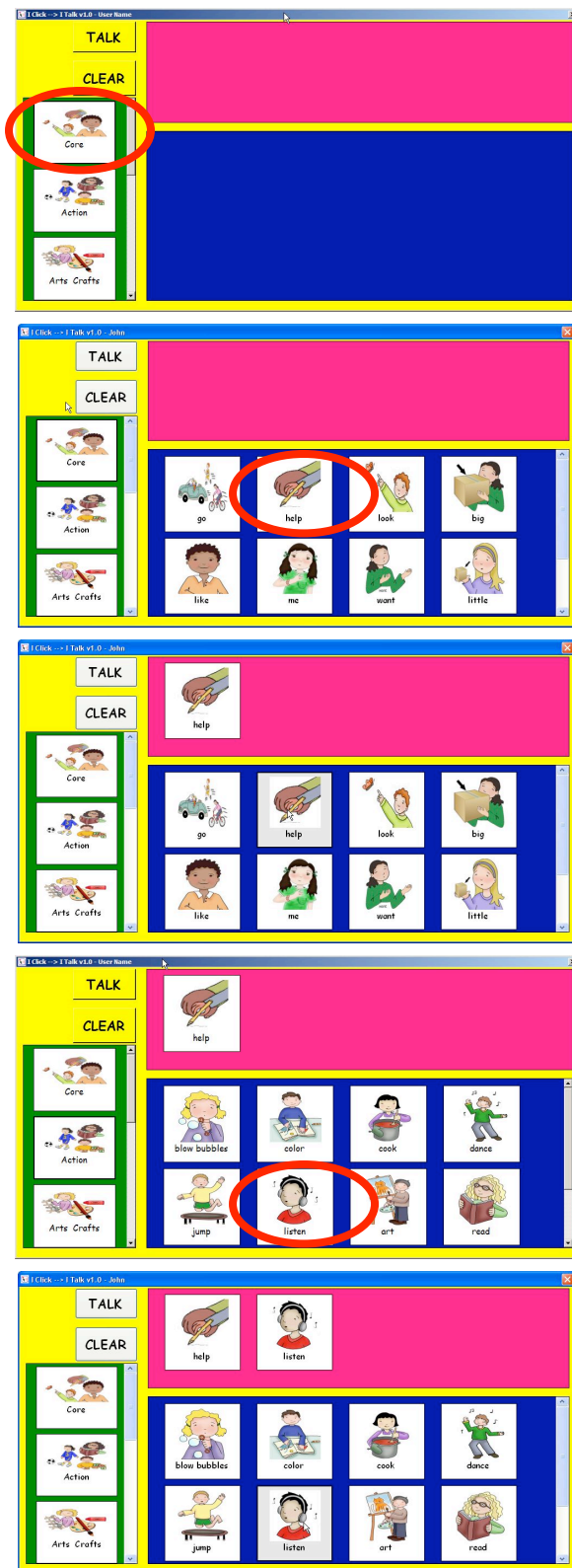


How to use I Click → I Talk

1. Click on an image from the frame on the left side of the window. The images on the left side of the window represent groups of related images.
2. After you click, a set of images (that relate to the image you selected in step one) will appear on the bottom right frame of the window.
3. When you click on an image in the bottom right frame of the window, that image will appear in the top right frame.
4. Repeat step 1 and 2 and 3 if you want to display more images in the top right frame.

Notes:

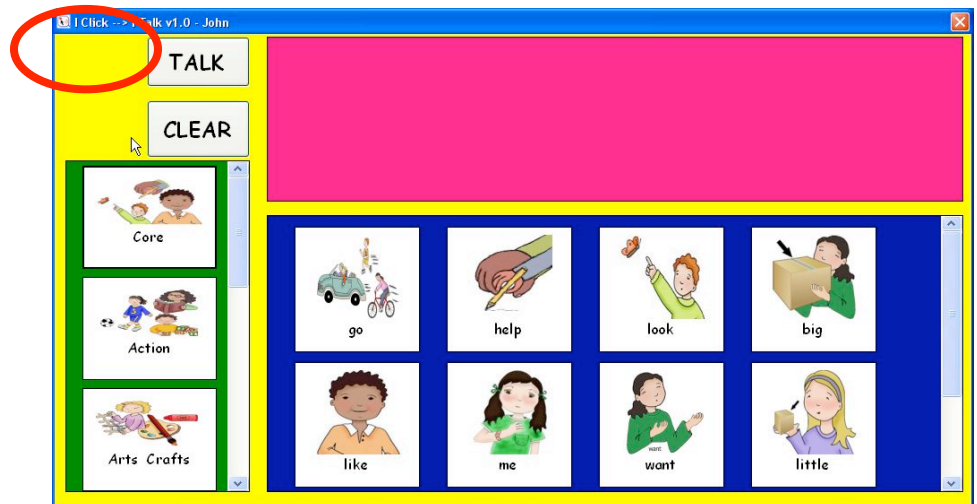
- If an audio file is associated with an image the audio will play.
- If you want to delete all the images from the top right frame click Clear. If you want to delete only one image from the top right frame just click on the image and it will disappear.
- If you want to return to the activity menu or change users click on the "X" on the top right corner of the window.



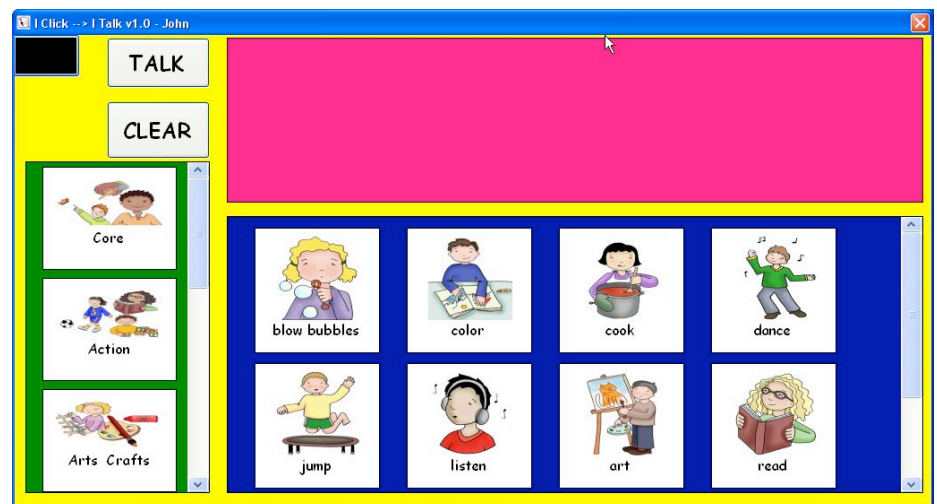
How to switch from user to manager

I Click → I Talk records the number of times a user selects an image. If you want to distinguish when the image is selected by the user or by the teacher/parent, follow these steps:

1. Click in the blank area in the top left corner of the window as shown in the image to the right.

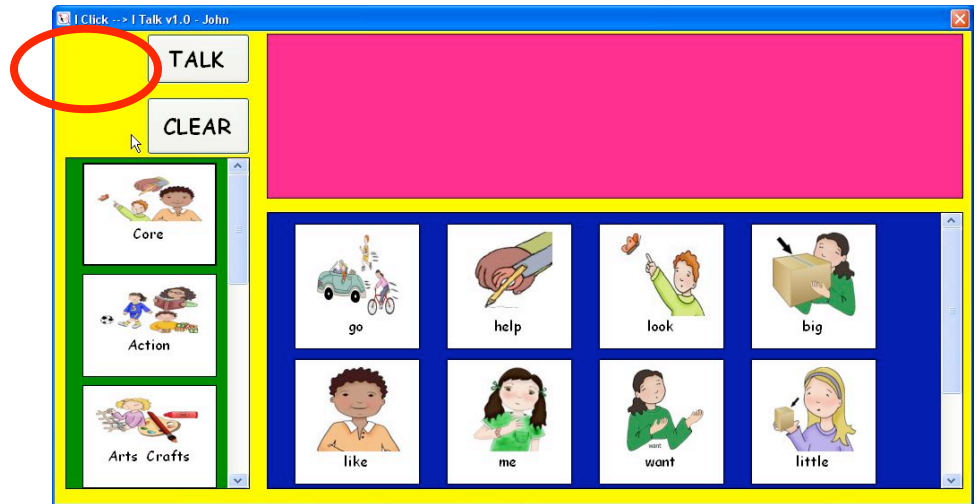


2. A black box will appear as shown in the image to the right.
4. Once the black box appears, the images you selected will be counted as teacher/parent.

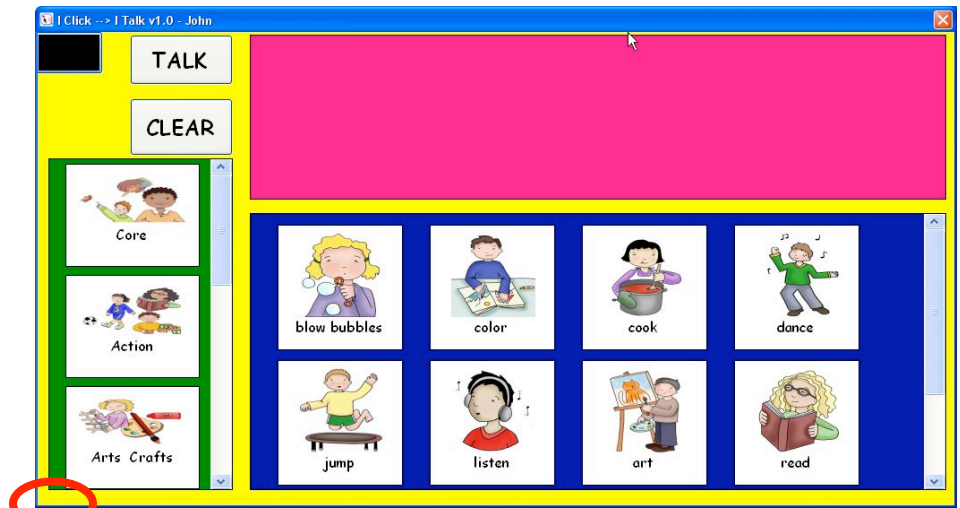


How to access the settings window of I Click → I Talk

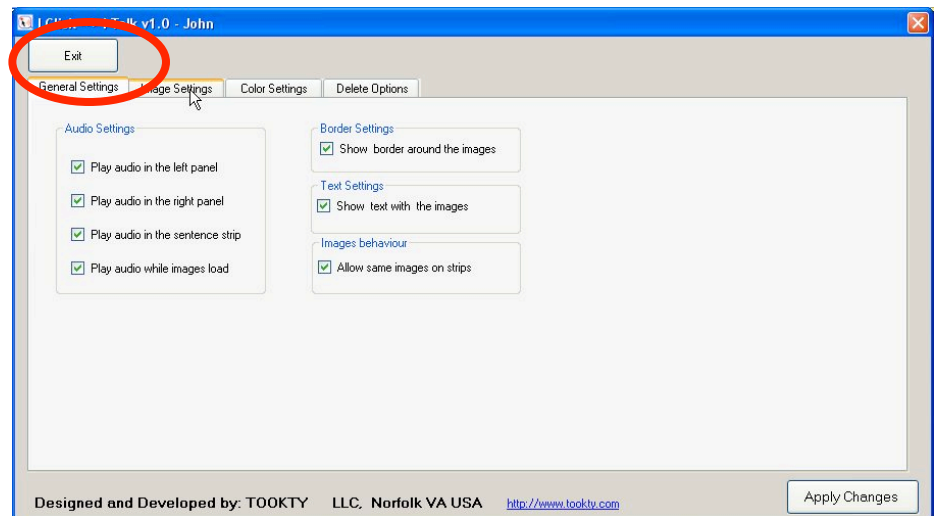
1. Click in the blank area in the top left corner of the window as shown in the image to the right.



2. A black box will appear as shown in the image to the right.
3. Once the black box appears, click on the bottom left corner of the window as shown in the image to the right.

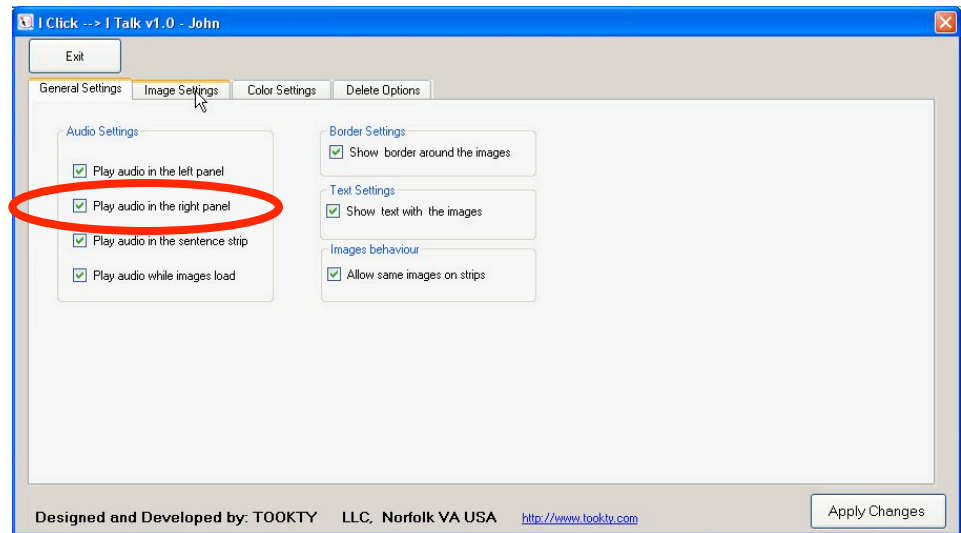


4. After you click, the settings window will appear. From this window you can edit the users' settings. Click on Exit button to return to the previous window.

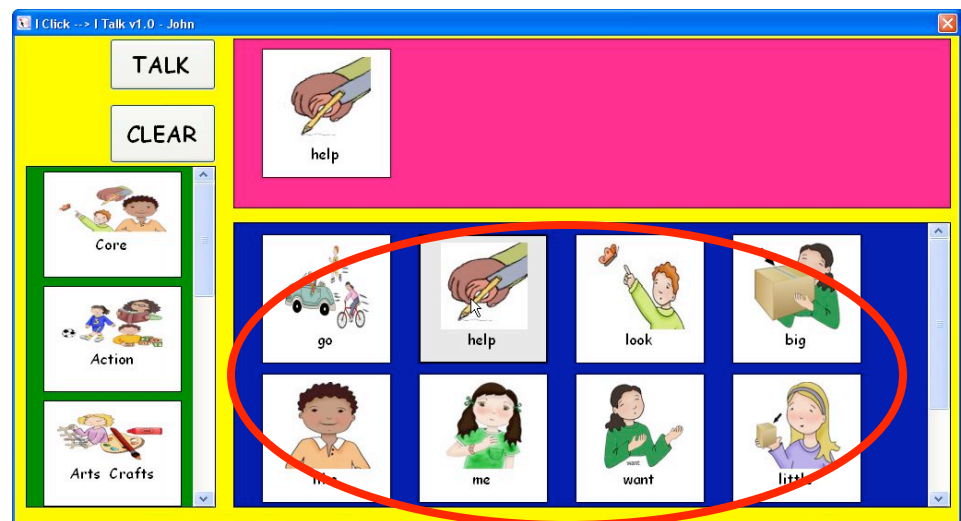


How to change the settings of I Click → I Talk

1. The checkboxes shown is the image to the right effect the I Click → I Talk window shown below.

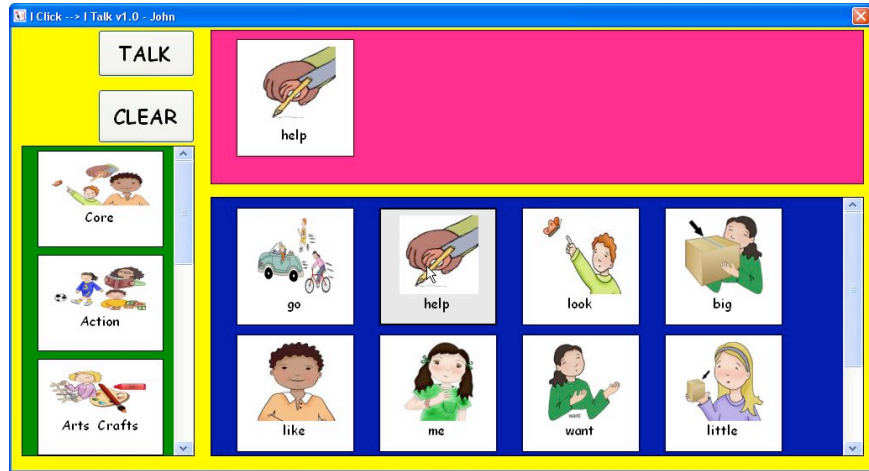


2. For example, if you deselect the option to play audio in the right panel (as show in the image to the top right) no audio file will play when you click on any of the images in the bottom right frame in the image to the right

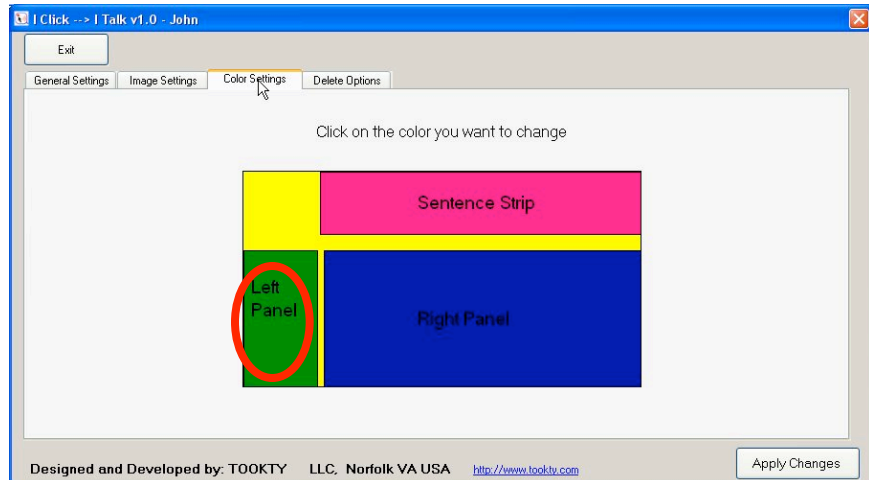


How to change the settings of I Click → I Talk

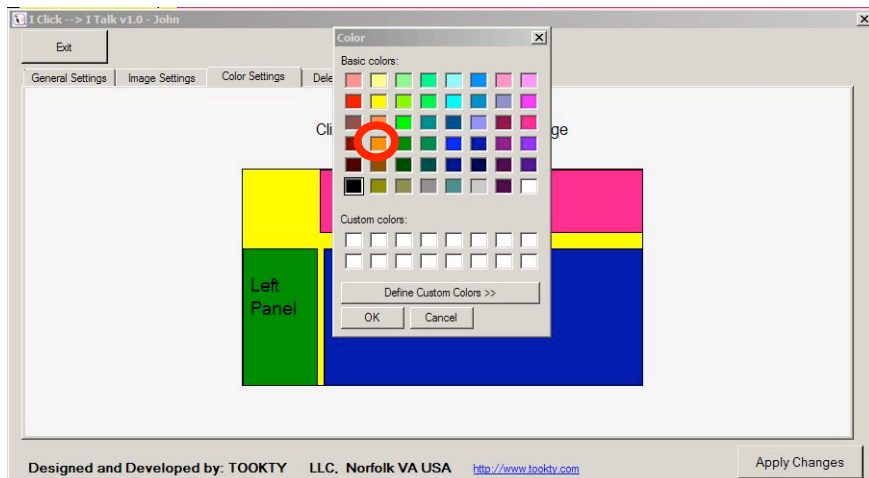
1. You can change the color of the background of the main I Click → I Talk application.



2. Click on the color of the panel you want to change as shown in the image to the right.

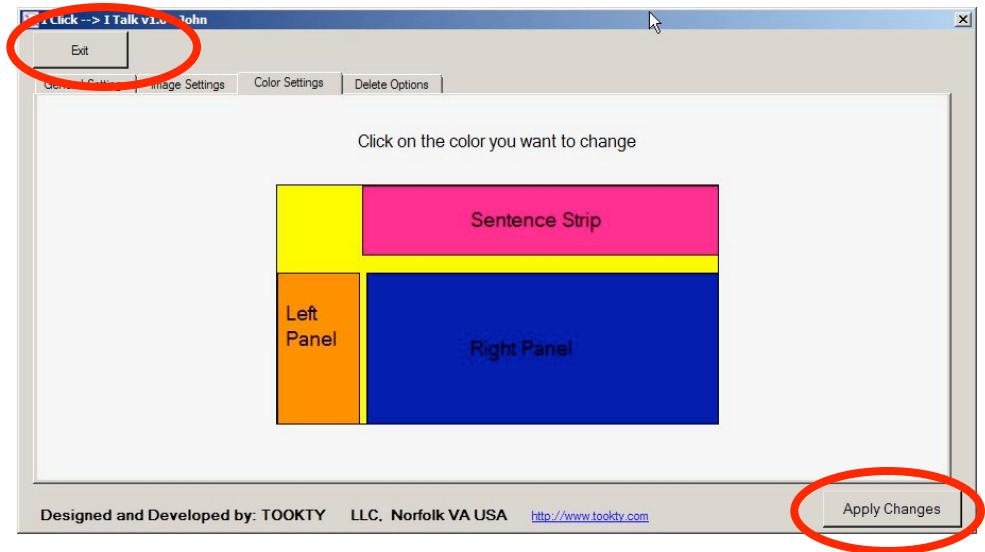


3. Select a new color as shown in the image to the right.

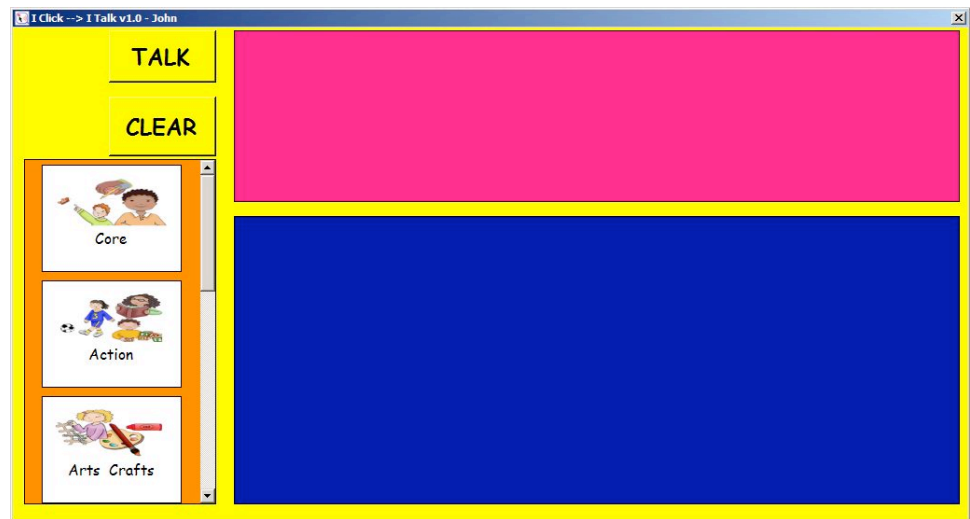


How to change the settings of I Click → I Talk

1. Click on Apply Changes, then click on Exit as shown in the image to the right.



2. The new colors will appear in the main I Click → I Talk window as shown in the image to the right.



How to change the settings of I Click → I Talk

1. From the windows below, you can delete:

- All the log files.
- All the audio files.
- All the information about the border around each of the images.
- All the texts of each of the images.

Remember that once you delete you cannot undo your choice.
